# Radical Race Car

This craft transforms a cracker box into a cool race car! Get ready for hours of excitement as children engage in imaginative play and proudly display their custom cars.

### STEP 1

Open up the cracker box by sliding your finger across all attached seams. Turn it inside out.

# STEP 2

For the cabin- ask an adult to help cut out a 5" x 6.5" rectanglular opening on the front panel of the box. Make sure the opening is 1.75" away from one the end of the box. Try to cut out the rectangular section in one piece. You will need the cardboard to make car details in a later step.

### STEP 3

- a. Tape the cracker box back together with the printing on the inside.
- b. If you'd like to add a windshield, snip in along the side edges about 1" and then fold the flap up.

Design your race car however you would like and color it with markers.

## STEP 5

- a. Ask an adult to help cut out the template. Trace the templates onto the cut-out rectangular piece from Step 2 to make four tires, two headlights, and the grille.
- b. Color them as you like! Tape them to the front of the car.

# STEP 6

- a. Have an adult poke holes in the side of the box for the wood dowels. Holes should be made 2" from the ends of the box and  $\frac{1}{2}$ " up from the bottom of the box.
- b. Insert the wood dowels through the holes.
- c. Have an adult poke a hole through the middle of each tire.
- d. Place the tires on the wood dowels.
